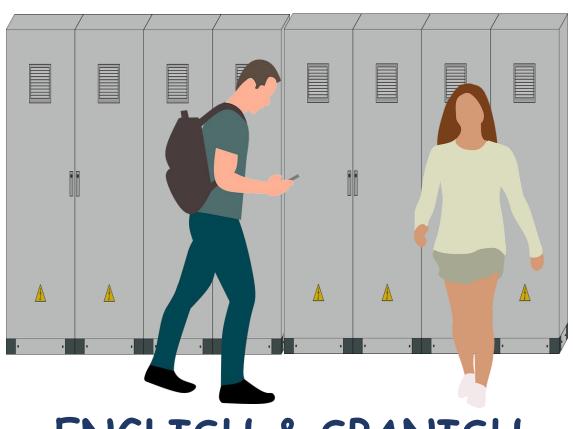

Description:
